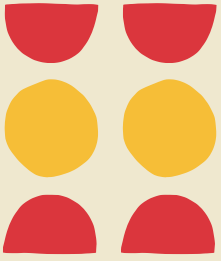


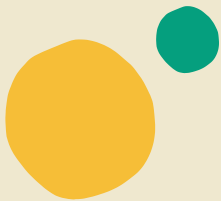
# KAREN EDLUND NURSE LEADER FELLOWSHIP

## OVERVIEW



The Karen Edlund (KE) Future Nurse Leader Fellowship fuels nursing students to leverage their power and become leaders in SRH, reproductive rights (RR) and Reproductive Justice (RJ). We believe that through intentional support and development of underrepresented nurses, we can shift the power structure of nursing and transform healthcare to not only include, but celebrate sexual and reproductive health.

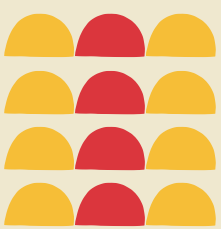
## FELLOWSHIP DESIGN



The Fellowship is 6 months. Fellows commit to 2.5 hours/week of study and action. This will include virtual events and webinars, peer-to-peer role plays/activities, professional development coaching, and individualized study through the NSRH Online Institute. Topics for these events and activities will range, including but not limited to:

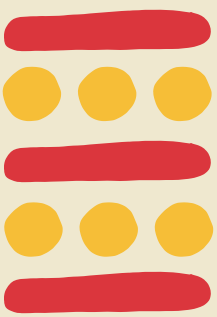
- Contraception
- Options Counseling
- Abortion 101
- Working with At-risk populations
- Job Hunting 101 & Interviewing
- Understanding Workplace Policies & Procedures
- Reproductive Justice for Nurses
- Institutional Advocacy
- Media and Messaging Training

## BENEFITS



For their participation, Fellows will receive a stipend of \$1,000 as well as free access to NSRH events and activities. Fellows also have access to the KE Advisory Council. The council is comprised of nurse experts who represent underrepresented identities and work within the SRH sector.

## NURSE LEADER PROJECT



In addition to the regular study and action, Fellows will be asked to complete a Nurse Leaders Project which they will work on throughout the course of their Fellowship. The goal of the Nurse Leaders Project is to help students achieve their personal and professional goals while advancing SRH, RJ, and RR in their community. Fellows are eligible to apply for up to \$300 of funding from NSRH to support them in completing this project.

Examples of potential projects include:

- Reproductive Justice Teach-In
- Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner student seminar
- NSRH Abortion Care Education (ACE) Elective campus symposium
- Transgender local community health guide
- Abortion fund fundraiser
